Granville Community Kitchen(GCK) is a community led food project which empowers our community through food. We are guided by principles of equity, respect and dignity. As an independent food aid provider we are open to all. We do not have a voucher or referral system. We do not ask questions. Any information shared with us is treated in the strictest of confidence.

FOOD DISTRIBUTION, PREPARATION, SERVING & CLEAN-UP

Our community meal is every Friday. Food is served 6:00-7:00pm.

During the COVID-19 crisis we are offering a Grab and Go hot meal takeaway and prepackaged food parcels. Some parcels will take into account dietary and religious requirements and will be clearly identified.

Food Preparation is from 3pm. Packers and cooks are expected to arrive at 3:00pm. Hosts and servers are expected to arrive at 5pm and stay through Clean-up, 7:30 or completed; tasks may vary

Please check in with Dee or Leslie who will familiarise you with the space and tasks. Do not hesitate to ask questions if unsure about anything

Food safety and hygiene practices dictate proper attire and good hygiene when working with food: NO HEELS/OPEN-TOED SHOES OR BARE FEET. Long hair must be tied back. Please be clean with fresh clothes and do not wear strong scented perfumes or colognes.

Aprons and gloves are required at all times when packing, serving or handling food

Wash hands using soap and water and put on gloves. Remember, ALWAYS WEAR GLOVES and change them often. Wash hands and put on new gloves after leaving your station/work area, when changing tasks, after touching hair, returning from the toilet, break/eating, sneezing/coughing, using mobile phones, etc. REMEMBER to remove your aprons before using toilets.
