



TRAINING FOR TRAINERS – MONEY COUNTS COURSE LEVEL 1

Course information and who should attend:

This course is aimed at anyone who is interested in delivering training on a cash first approach to income maximisation in their local area.

The training is focused around poverty and the use of the Independent Food Aid Network (IFAN) 'Worrying About Money?' leaflet and aims to facilitate good conversations about money worries.

The course will be useful for participants where a 'Worrying About Money' leaflet is already in circulation, but this is not a prerequisite to attend the training as links can be made with IFAN to take forward the co-development of a leaflet in your area.

On completion of the training, participants will be provided with access to the training materials to run their own Money Count Level 1 training.

The course will be delivered on Microsoft TEAMS. A link will be provided for the first 16 people who register to join the training.

The training aims to:

- Equip trainers with the knowledge and resources to run the Money Counts Level 1 course.
- Introduce the training package and detail what is included in the training and why.
