

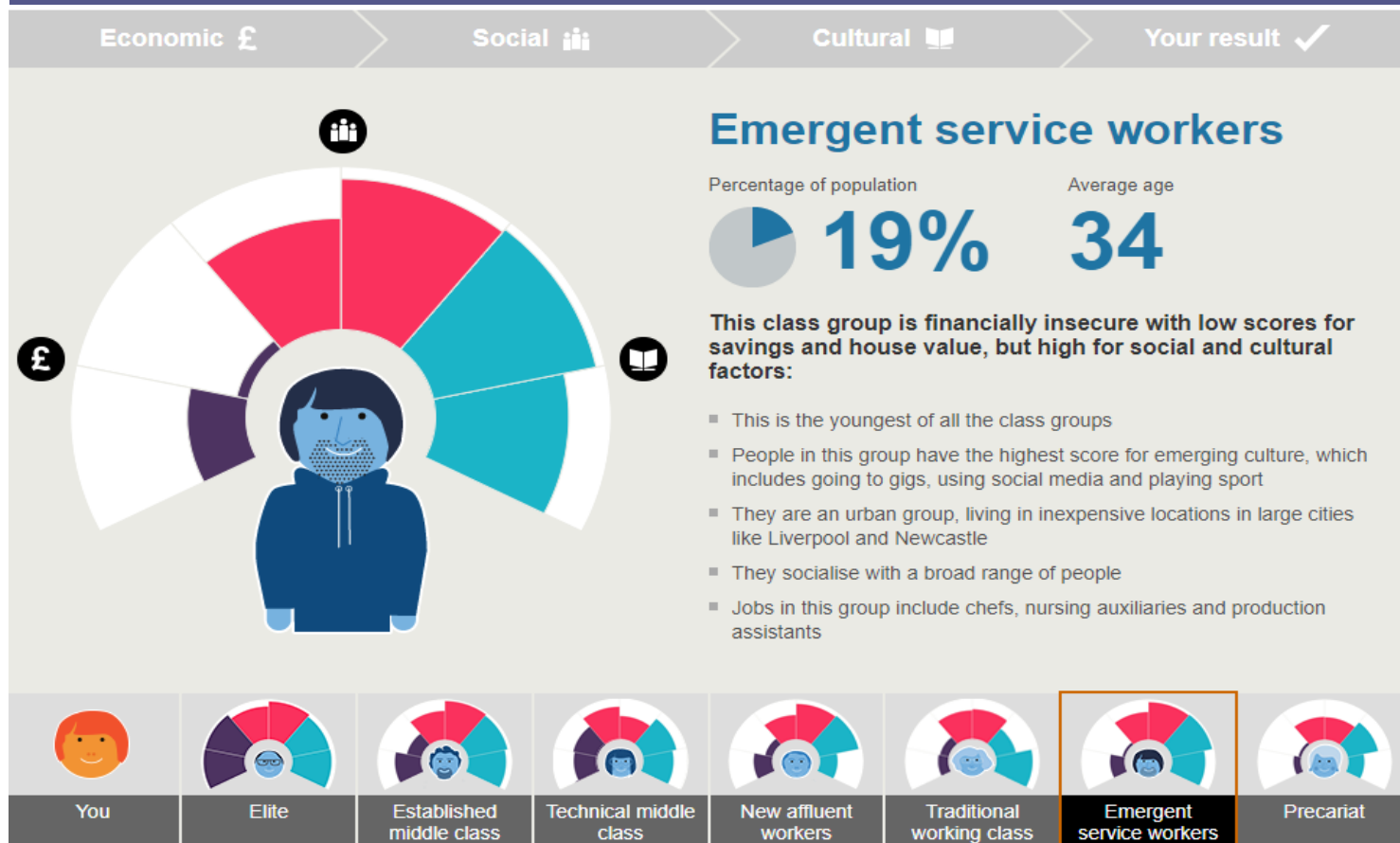

Bourdieuian approach

- Cultural Capital
 - Music taste, leisure activities etc.
- Social Capital
 - Your contacts
- Economic Capital
 - Earnings and assets
- Cultural cap + Social cap + Economic cap = Class

Blaming the Poor

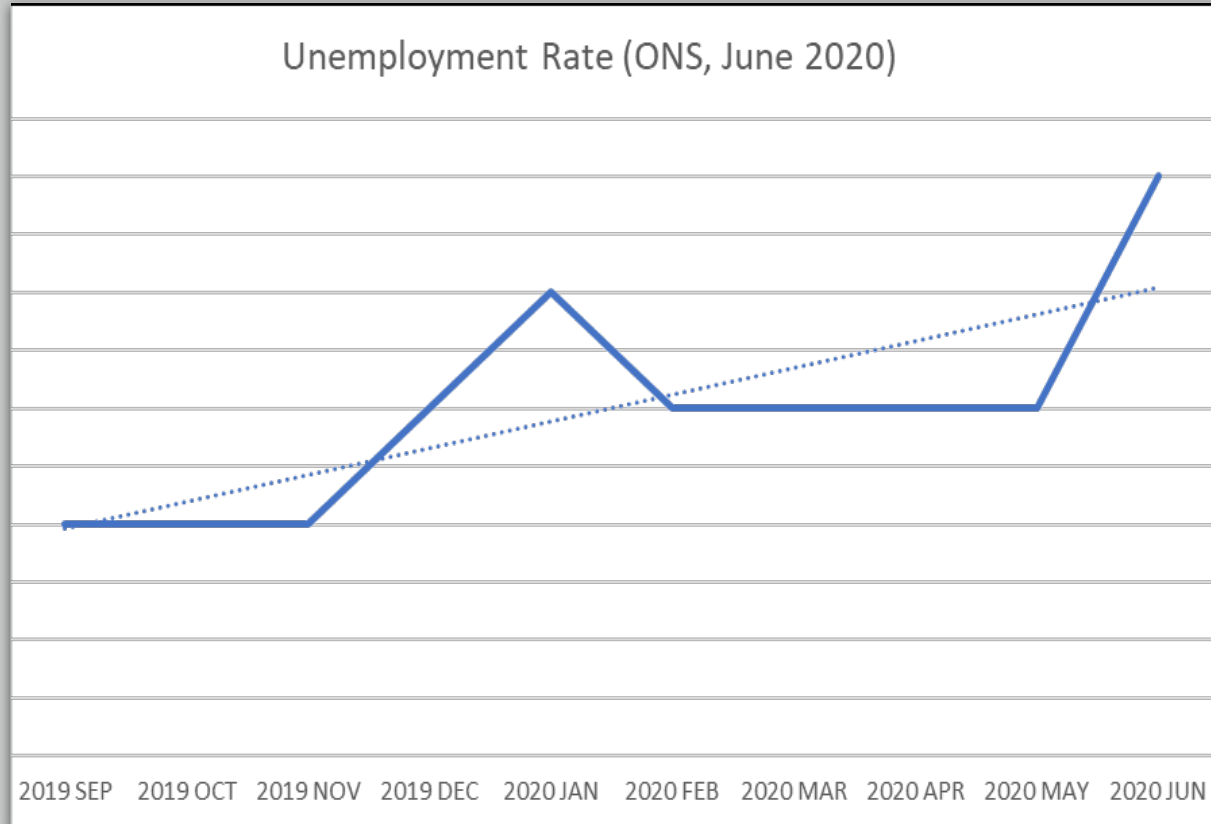
- Dog-Whistling
