#### 2018 Research

- 88% of people accessing the foodbank believe they are suitable places to host advice and support services
- More than half of people accessing the foodbank say they are not receiving expert help with their problems
- People accessing the foodbank urgently want and need help to maximise income from benefits. Clients identified benefits issues as both immediate triggers for their foodbank use and underlying causes.
- people accessing the foodbank also want help with debts, especially issues with energy bills.

# What MAS do

The Money Advice Service is a free, impartial and confidential service, tailored to meet people needs

- Applying for benefits, including appeals and tribunals
- Budgeting support
- Applying for and issuing cash grants
- Personal debt advice
- Tailored support

We have 6 FTE Welfare Right Advisers, 3 FTE Support Officers and 1 MAS Manager.

- Triage helpline
- Drop in at foodbank centres
- Attendance at EFP hosted community events

## The difference they make

- Secured over £357,000 (YTD 2324) in financial gains
- The highest financial gain for one person was over £25,000 and an average of £1,769 per person.
- 70% of people who connect with MAS receive a financial gain
- Over 130 people received £150 energy cash grants
